DESCRIPTION:

Bass Coast Health (BCH) offers off-site accommodation within close proximity of the hospital. The offsite accommodation provided by BCH are modern styled houses/units varying in the number of bedrooms (1-5 rooms). For security purposes all bedroom's doors and bathrooms/toilets can be locked. Each house generally has two toilets, a shared bathroom and an ensuite in the master bedroom. There is a shared kitchen, dining and lounge space equipped with furniture and a TV for tenants to utilise. All cooking & kitchen utensils are available for residents to use as you wish. Heating/cooling is provided for tenants in communal spaces.

Each bedroom comprises of a double or king single bed with basic linen and towels supplied, study desk, chair and lamp. Residents are welcome to bring any home comforts such as their own doona, quilts or pillows etc.

Basic cleaning products and equipment are supplied. It is an expectation of tenants to regularly vacuum and clean the floors in communal areas, clean the bathrooms/toilets and wipe down the kitchen surfaces/appliances. Laundry facilities are also provided including a washing machine, dryer, clothes airer, iron & ironing board.

Cleaners will only visit the property to restock cleaning items etc when requested through accommodation or to clean a room/unit once a tenant has vacated the property. Cleaning staff will not clean the property or bedrooms for the duration of your stay. We would appreciate if your bedroom and communal spaces were kept clean at all times.

Please be mindful, respectful and considerate of any occupants residing in the property at all times. Conducting yourself in accordance with hospital codes of conduct and behaviour.

MAP:

On collection of your keys you will be provided a map of how to get to your offsite accommodation.

ACCOMMODATION COSTS:

Students: \$25.00 per night capped at \$125.00 per week. Includes WIFI & cleaning costs.

OCCUPANCY:

During your stay occupants must comply with the below points:

- Clean bedrooms and communal areas regularly, including the bathrooms/toilets.
- Empty internal rubbish bins & place bagged rubbish in the external wheelie bins
- **Residents are not permitted** to smoke inside the house. Bass Coast Health is a totally smoke free environment.
- Overnight visitors are <u>not permitted</u> without receiving approval from other tenants first. This includes partners and friends
- No animals are permitted in any of the shared houses
- Respect others sharing the accommodation

PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

Bass Coast Health insurance does not cover occupant belongings, which should be separately insured by occupants if they are concerned by loss or damage.

KEYS:

Keys can be collected from the Main Hospital Reception between 14:00 and 21:00 on the day of arrival Monday to Sunday, after hours the HSC can be contacted on 5671 3384 to assist where needed.

HEATING/COOLING:

There is a split system in most of the communal lounge areas. It is the occupants responsibility to turn off A/C and heaters. Please ensure you check this each time you leave the premises.

MAINTENANCE:

Occupants are responsible for the care of furniture and equipment in the house. If you cause any damage, other than fair wear and tear, you will be invoiced for any necessary repairs. Damage, faults or required maintenance should be reported to 5671 3102.

CLEANING:

On departure, the house should be left in the same condition as it was on arrival. An inspection will be completed after departure and occupants will be billed for any extra cleaning required to return the premises to the original state.

RIGHT OF ENTRY:

BCH reserves the right to enter the house in approved situations such as health and safety activities, smoke detector tests, routine inspections, maintenance activities and actual or suspected emergencies.

RUBBISH:

Please empty any internal rubbish into the large rubbish & recycling wheelie bins outside & place curb side each Thursday evening ready for Friday's collection, with Green every week & Yellow/Red on alternative weeks.

DEPARTURE:

On the day of departure, please ensure you have all of your belongings, removing any food from the refrigerator/pantry and leave your bedroom door open and unlocked. <u>Please return accommodation keys</u> <u>back to the Main Hospital reception before or by 9:00 Monday – Sunday. Outside of reception hours (7:00-9:00), keys can be returned to the HSC.</u>

LATE CHECK-OUT:

Failure to return the keys to BCH by 9:00am on the day of your scheduled check out may result in a **\$100 late check-out fee** unless otherwise pre-arranged. Please contact the Accommodation Coordinator on 5671 3102 prior to scheduled checkout if you are unable to return the keys on time.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY:

If there is a need to contact 000 in the event on an emergency, Bass Coast Health must be notified after the call to 000 has been made. This is to ensure all staff and students are safe. Contact the Accommodation Coordinator on 5671 3102 or the Health Services Coordinator on 5671 3884.
